- **Key to the Blend:** Using different clones within a given vineyard allows us to create individual, clonal fermentation lots – each contributing a key flavor to the final wine.

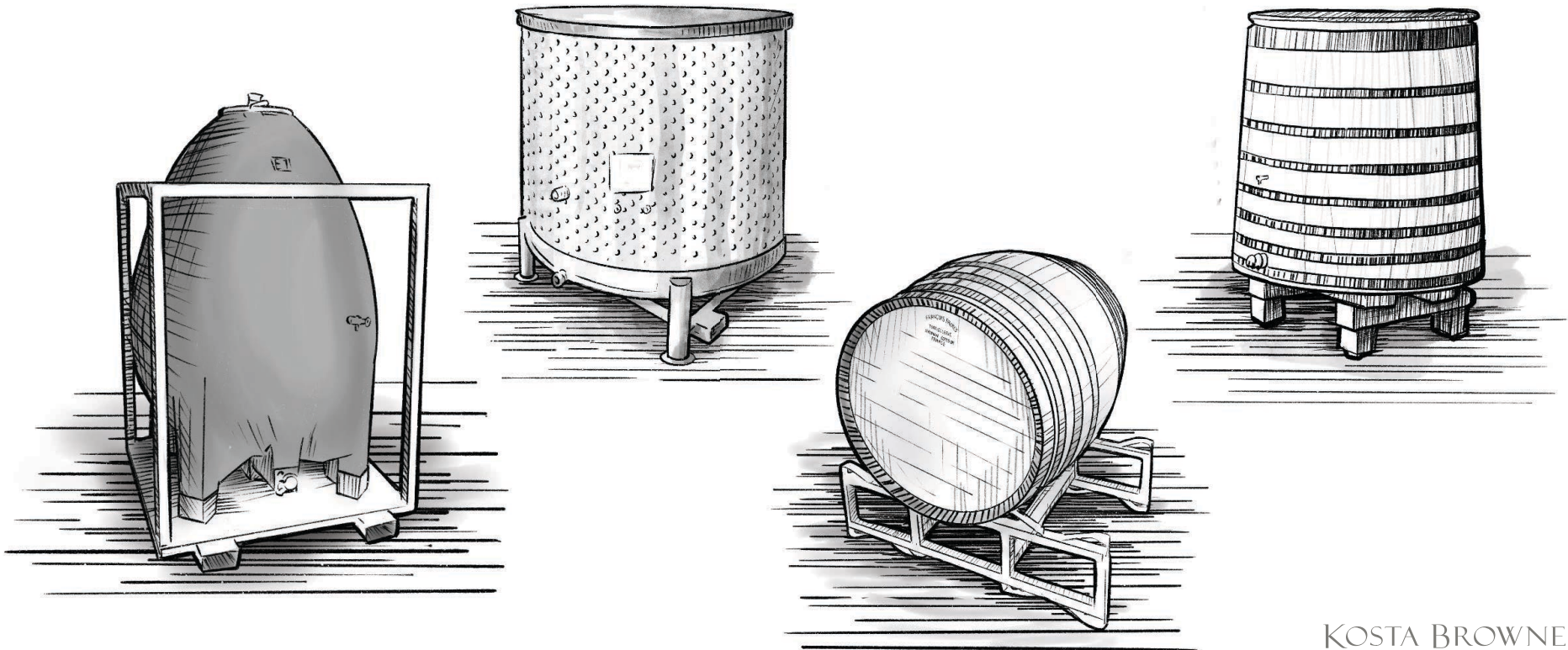

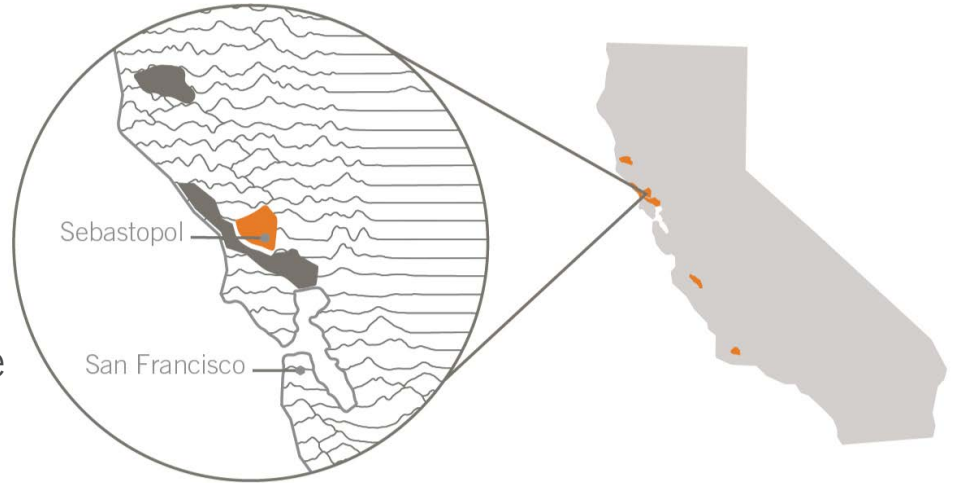

## 2022 ONE-SIXTEEN, RUSSIAN RIVER VALLEY PINOT NOIR

### WINEMAKER NOTES

The marine influence that follows the Russian River inland from the Pacific coast is a powerful attribute of this region. The fog helps keep nights cool and offers vines a break from daytime temperatures.

This synergistic Chardonnay unveils a precisely structured palate with captivating aromatics. Notes of kiwi, lavender, and baking spice delight while complementing the pristine acidity. Individual pressed lots were all 100% native primary and malolactic fermentations, adding a profound depth and length to a refined finish.

## 2022 RUSSIAN RIVER VALLEY PINOT NOIR

### WINEMAKER NOTES

There are many differences between vineyards in this small appellation, but the majority of them share a common influence – the cooling effect that follows the Russian River inland from the Pacific coast.

We have been fortunate to work with vineyards that span a diverse and varied view into a region that many would call the heartland of California Pinot Noir. Revealing enticing aromas of dark red cherry, blueberry, and raspberry, this Pinot Noir is both flavorful and poised. A refreshing lift gracefully traverses the palate, leading to a captivatingly long finish.

## 2022 SONOMA COAST PINOT NOIR

### WINEMAKER NOTES

The Sonoma Coast is the largest appellation in Sonoma County, strongly influenced by its proximity to the ocean and heavy rainfall—producing more than twice the annual amount of its inland neighbors.

This distinctive blend is made from 11 different clones, fermented in predominantly stainless steel, and aged for 16 months in 38% new oak. The resulting wine has an energetic acidity with cascading layers of black cherry and elderberry, followed by a lasting finish.

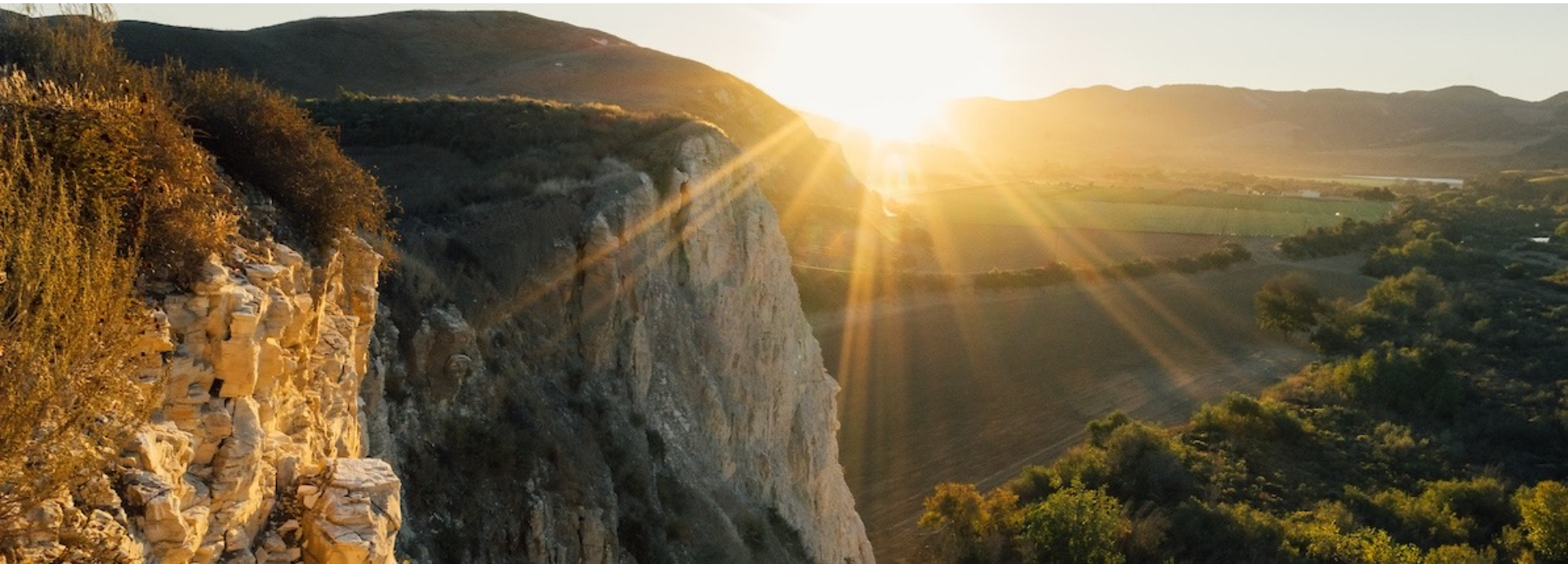
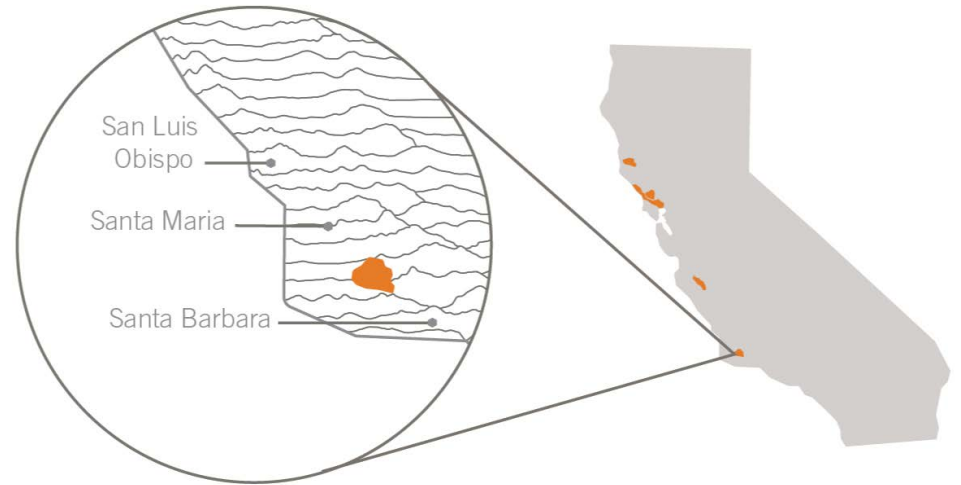

## 2022 STA. RITA HILLS PINOT NOIR

### WINEMAKER NOTES

The Sta. Rita Hills is located on the Central Coast in Santa Barbara County. Though one of the smaller AVAs in California, it is celebrated worldwide as an acclaimed cool-climate growing region for Pinot Noir.

The purely East/West maritime mouth that funnels cooling coastal fog and wind to the vines make this area truly unique. As a result, Pinot Noir from this region characteristically has beautiful natural acidity balanced by complex structure and concentrated flavors.

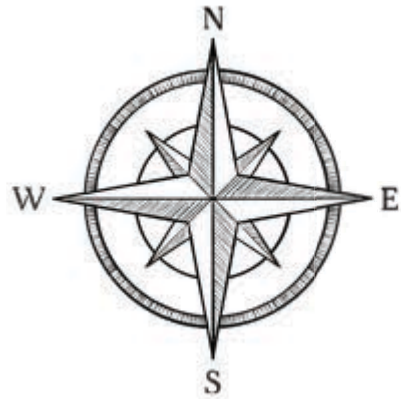

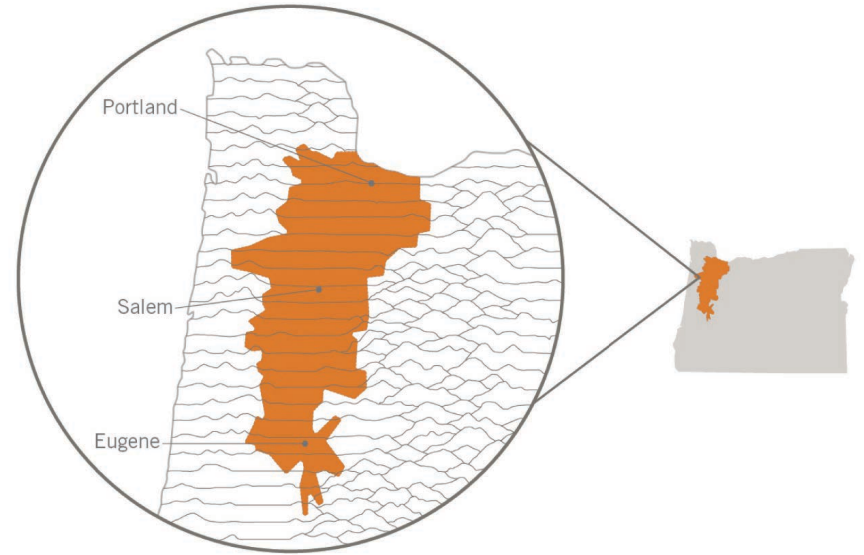

### WINEMAKER NOTES

For over 25 years, our dedication to exploration and passion for crafting soulful and thought-provoking wines led us through the diverse terroirs of California, to the revered vineyards of Burgundy, France, and now to Oregon's majestic Willamette Valley.

The wine offers a captivating sensory journey, revealing expressive notes of black and red fruit, dried herbs, and spices. Fermented in stainless steel with 5% whole cluster inclusion to preserve the wine's vibrant acidity, this Pinot Noir boasts seamlessly integrated oak, culminating in an enduring finish.

## ONE-SIXTEEN RUSSIAN RIVER VALLEY CHARDONNAY

The marine influence that follows the Russian River inland from the Pacific coast is a powerful attribute of this region. The fog helps keep nights cool and offers the vines a well-deserved break from daytime temperatures. The famed Chardonnay vineyards that we work with for this wine are located in the coolest parts of the Russian River Valley. Here, fruit can mature gracefully on the vine, offering more intensely focused flavors. The palate strikes a lovely balance between richness and bright acidity, with succulent orchard fruit flavors and a kiss of French oak carrying the wine to a long, shimmering finish.



## RUSSIAN RIVER VALLEY PINOT NOIR

There are many differences between vineyards in this small appellation, but the majority of them share a common influence – the cooling effect that follows the Russian River inland from the Pacific coast. Over the years, we've been fortunate to work with many great vineyards that span a diverse and varied view into a region that many would call the heartland of California Pinot Noir. No matter the vintage, there are often fresh red fruit characteristics, a recognizably full mouthfeel, and lively texture to the wines from the area - a common thread to the components of this blend.



## SONOMA COAST PINOT NOIR

The Sonoma Coast appellation overlaps with the Russian River Valley in many places and is similarly shaped by the ocean. Local geology can be complex here, a result of being located at the intersection of two tectonic plates. We find ourselves drawn to sites that are influenced by the Pacific Ocean. The vineyards we source from lie in both the southern portion of the appellation and in the northern coastal zone. In the southern area, the Petaluma Wind Gap and the San Pablo Bay drive cooler temperatures and provide us with deep flavors and richly textured wines. The vineyards from the coastal reaches contribute savory and spice characteristics that we love, as well as add great structure and poise. Together, they form a distinct Sonoma Coast wine with enticing aromas of ripe blue fruit, layered acidity, and a powerful finish.



## STA. RITA HILLS PINOT NOIR

A microclimate that began a mere 20 million years ago is nothing short of a miracle. Tectonic plate movements caused mountains to rise out of the ocean, break off the plate, and rotate clockwise, creating one of the most defined transverse ranges on the Pacific Coast, with remnants of marine sediment deposited during the Miocene Epoch as the soil base. But what makes this area truly unique is the purely East/West maritime mouth that funnels cooling coastal fog and wind to the vines. Sta. Rita Hills is one of the world's best cool-climate growing regions of Pinot Noir. As captivating as it is delicious, this wine is robust and dynamic, with intense fruit and spice notes continuing throughout the palate, building to a complex and polished finish.



## WILLAMETTE VALLEY PINOT NOIR

The storied soils of Willamette Valley are shaped by the historic release of an ice dam from glacial Lake Missoula that caused massive flooding across Washington, down the Columbia River, and into Oregon, carrying treasures of ancient glaciofluvial sediment. Now home to some of the deepest alluvial deposits, eroded basalts, and uplifted sea beds, these soils are a Pinot Noir dream. The wine offers a captivating sensory journey, revealing expressive notes of black and red fruit, dried herbs, and spices while boasting seamlessly integrated oak that culminates in an enduring finish.

## 2022 GAP'S CROWN VINEYARD SONOMA COAST PINOT NOIR

### WINEMAKER NOTES

Gap's Crown Vineyard is widely recognized as one of the most exceptional expressions of the Petaluma Gap AVA, the southern region of the renowned Sonoma Coast appellation. Since our partnership with this vineyard commenced in 2006, it has soared to remarkable heights, earning its esteemed status among the finest Pinot Noir vineyards.

The 2022 vintage of Gap's Crown Vineyard Pinot Noir was crafted from five carefully selected clones, each contributing unique characteristics to the wine. Fermentation was conducted in both stainless steel and wood vessels, using 8% whole clusters, then aged for 16 months in barrel, with its final month spent in stainless steel to ensure a harmonious integration of flavors.

We methodically select clones and rootstocks, highlighting the vineyards' purest expressions, and utilize 20 different fermentation vessels to complement each lot produced. Each estate wine reflects the most compelling characteristics of the site from which they hail.

# ESTATE SERIES

## 2021 CERISE VINEYARD ANDERSON VALLEY PINOT NOIR

### WINEMAKER NOTES

Cerise Vineyard has emerged as one of Anderson Valley's most acclaimed vineyards, with hillsides reaching 1,600 feet and exposures that push the vines to their limits. Pinot Noir blocks sit on the eastern side of the valley, facing west, 16 miles from the coast. There is not a single block that rests on flat ground.

From its mesmerizing core of bright, concentrated fruit to its soft, chalky tannins and subtle underlying tension, this wine is classic Cerise. Crafted from six elite clones and fermented in stainless steel, concrete, and oak tanks, this Pinot's structure draws you in and delights with layers of raspberry and blood orange for a long, fascinating finish.

Located in the Petaluma Gap off of the Sonoma Coast, Kosta Browne has been fortunate to work with Gap's Crown Vineyard since 2006. Steep hillsides and a variety of clones add diversity while carefully planted aspects encourage even sunlight exposure during the final stages of ripening. It was also a contributing vineyard to our 2009 vintage—named Wine Spectator's #1 Wine of the Year in 2011.

In 2016 Kosta Browne jumped at the opportunity to purchase this incredible site.
