
How Kosta Browne works

- DTC Channel & Promote strategy
 - Allocations based tenure and preference
 - Wishes used to prevent oversell
 - Promote strategy crafted for months before roll-out to balance supply vs demand
- Pricing
 - Members always rewarded with lowest price. FOBs are 75-100% of member price
- Leverage DWC Wholesale & DTC properties to drive engagement, membership, sales

Signing Up New Members

Building the Kosta Browne Allocation List

Most wineries use DtC activity & marketing to support the Wholesale channel. Kosta Browne uniquely flips this model, successfully using the Wholesale channel to drive new member sign-ups for our allocation list, which generates the majority of our sales & revenue.

Driving new member consumer sign-ups is critical for Kosta Browne's growth and success.

- Kosta Browne New Member sign-up cards will be available on the POS Nest for ordering and use at appropriate events, meetings, etc.
- You are also encouraged to direct prospective members to the Kosta Browne website where they can sign-up by clicking *Join Us.*

The average waiting period before new signups receive access to an offering are as follows:

- 18 -24 months for the Appellation Series in the Spring offering
- 3 5 years for the Single Vineyard Grower Series in the Fall offering
- 4 8 years for the Single Vineyard Estate Series in the Summer offering
- 10 years+ for the famous "4 Barrel"
