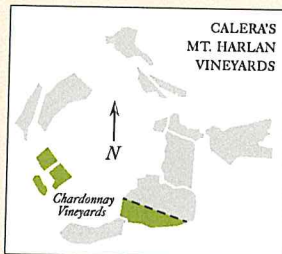

2016 CHARDONNAY MT. HARLAN

In 1975, legendary vintner and pioneer Josh Jensen founded Calera (Spanish for "lime kiln") high on the majestic slopes of Mt. Harlan in the Gavilan Mountains of California's Central Coast. In these low-yielding, limestone-rich soils and cool, arid climate, he began planting our estate vineyards that are recognized as some of the New World's most treasured Pinot Noir sites.
